

Summer Learning 2019 Entering Grade 1

Summer Learning activities provide students with opportunities to practice the skills they acquired this year so that they enter the new school year ready to learn. This summer, students entering Grade 1 will be expected to complete required summer reading, writing, and math activities. Students may also complete optional technology activities. Reading:

Students will read *If You Give a Mouse a Cookie* by Laura Numeroff. Please complete the sequencing activity included in this folder with your child. In addition, students are encouraged to read from other fiction and nonfiction selections. Please read 2 - 3 picture books each week with your child and assist your child in entering their reading selections on the attached reading log.

Writing:

Students will complete at least 3 journal entries. Each entry will have a minimum of 3 sentences. Students are encouraged to illustrate their journal entries.

Math:

Each student will receive a summer learning math packet to complete. These pages contain problems based on concepts your child has learned this year.

Please complete all reading, writing, and math activities and turn them in to your new teacher by August 15.
