- Word scramble
- Spelling with movement (pretending to dribble a ball, kicking, cheering, dancing, etc.)
- Make a memory game
- Tic-Tac-Toe board with the words
- Find the words in a magazine, newspaper, book
- Make the words with Play-doh or Wiki Sticks
