

Summer Learning 2019 Entering Grade 3

Summer Learning activities provide students with opportunities to practice the skills they acquired this year so that they enter the new school year ready to learn. This summer, students entering Grade 3 will be expected to complete required summer reading, writing, and math activities. Students may also complete optional technology activities. Details and additional information are attached.

Reading:

Students will read *School Days According to Humphrey* by Betty G. Birney. In addition, each student will read from sources of their choosing in order to reach their individual reading goal.

Writing:

Students will complete at least 3 journal entries. Each entry will have a minimum of 10 sentences, will begin with a hook, and will end with a wrap-around ending.

Math:

Each student will receive a summer learning math packet composed of extra math practice sheets from their math workbook. These pages contain problems based on concepts learned this year.

Please complete all reading, writing, and math activities and turn them in to your new teacher by August 15.
