Journal Entry Guidelines

- For your summer reading journal, you will need to complete at least 6 journal entries.
- Each entry must be at least 3-5 paragraphs in length with your name and date at the top, written or typed.
- You will need to staple all journal entries together to turn in to your 6th-grade teacher.
- Three of your journal entries must be informative in nature, describing a place you have visited, or something you have done or seen.
- Three of your journal entries must be reading responses about your summer reading. One of these reflections needs to be about *The Giver* by Lois Lowry, and the other two can be about books of your choice. Please see the instructions below for writing your reading responses.

Reading Response

Think about all of the elements of fiction and nonfiction text that we have learned about.

Fiction: Character, setting, rising action, climax, problem, resolution, and theme.

Nonfiction: Main ideas and details, structure, connections within the text, increasing complexity (vocabulary, main ideas, sentence structure, details/information).

Include/explain some of these ideas in your reading responses as they relate to the books you are reading.
