

# Summer Learning 2019 Entering Grade 6

Summer Learning activities provide students with opportunities to practice the skills they acquired this year so that they enter the new school year ready to learn. This summer, students entering Grade 6 will be expected to complete required summer reading, writing, and math activities. Students may also complete optional technology activities. ## Reading:

Students will read *The Giver* by Lois Lowry. In addition, each student will read from sources of their choosing in order to reach their individual reading goal.

# Writing:

Each student will complete 6 journal entries that are 3 to 5 paragraphs and at least one full page each. Students may write or type their entries.

#### Math:

Each student will receive a summer learning math packet composed of extra math practice sheets from their math workbook. These pages contain problems based on concepts learned this year. Please complete this packet and turn it in to your new teacher by August 15.
