Journal Entry Guidelines

- For your summer reading journal, you will need to complete at least 5 journal entries.
- Each entry must be at least 3 paragraphs in length with your name and date at the top, written or typed.
- You will need to staple all journal entries together to turn in to your 5th grade teacher.
- Two of your journal entries must be informative in nature, describing a place you have visited, or something you have done or seen.
- Three of your journal entries must be reading reflections about your summer reading. One of these reflections needs to be about *The Indian in the Cupboard* by Lynne Reid Banks, and the other two can be about books of your choice. Please see the instructions below for writing your reading reflections.

Think about all of the Notice and Note signposts that you have learned in 4th grade:

Contrasts and Contradictions, Tough Questions, Again and Again, Memory Moment, Aha! Moment, and Words of the Wiser
