



Summer Learning 1-2-3 WRITE

Summer writing can be fun, you'll see. It's as simple as 1-2-3!

ONE!

Students will receive a journal for summer writing. Teachers will discuss journaling expectations and allow students to begin using these journals in class during the month of May.

TWO!

Students will continue adding entries to their journals throughout the summer. The minimum number of entries are as follows, but students may write as many additional entries as they choose.

Required number of journal entries by grade:

- Entering 2nd: 3
- Entering 3rd: 3
- Entering 4th: 4
- Entering 5th: 5
- Entering 6th: 6

THREE!

When students finish books they have chosen for summer reading, they will write the titles on the Summer Reading Log found on the back of the Summer Learning Checklist. Remember to record all summer reading, not just the minimum six books required. Please turn in your log to your new teacher on the first day of school.
