How can you help your child continue to learn over the summer?

Read with your child daily!

Ask questions about the story that require him/her to think about the answer, not respond with “yes” or “no” answers. Have them sequence the events that happened in the story by either retelling verbally or drawing simple pictures that retell their favorite parts. Let your child finish the pages in their journal or make a summer journal! Take it with you on vacation! Journaling is a great activity to practice sounds and letters.

Practice math skills and language!

Practice math facts to 10 using counting objects and ten frame cards. Card games are a fun way to recognize numbers and practice sequencing and problem solving. Remember to use language that we have used in our classrooms:

- more than, less than
- equal, is the same as
- part/part/whole
- _____ and _____ make _____ (example: 5 and 4 make 9)

Practice red words (sight words), color words, and number words with your child! These are words your child learned in Kindergarten this year.

Red Words: a, and, are, away, can, come, do, find, for, funny, go, good, has, have, here, his, her, he, help, is, in, I, like, look, little, make, me, my, out, play, put, said, saw, she, see, the, to, they, very, want, was, we, what, where, who, you

Color words: red, orange, green, brown, brown, black, purple, pink

Number words: one, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight, nine, ten
